

2020 Connecticut Youth Employment Program (CYEP) Eligibility Documentation

In order to complete your application, you will need to upload documentation into the application to verify the following eligibilities. If you are unable to provide the documentation through the application, you will have the chance to provide it directly to the community provider at intake. We urge you, however, to upload what you can, as it will make your application process quicker.

DCF-Involved	You have an active case with DCF or are in the foster care system	Letter from Department of Children and Families (i.e.: a letter from your caseworker)
Work Authorization	You are legally eligible to work in the United States	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • US passport OR • Alien registration card OR • School or state photo ID and social security card OR • US birth certificate
School Status	If you are in college, the 12th grade or below at the time of the application	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • College transcript • School transcript or report card
Residency	You are a resident of the Northwest Connecticut Region	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transcript or report card OR • Utility bill or similar bill that shows your address
Age	Must be between 14 and 21 years old as of July 1, 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Birth certificate OR • State or government photo ID OR • Transcript or report card
Disability and/or Special Needs	School records, letter from BRS, letter from DMHAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IEP/PPT • 504 letter • Letter from BRS or DMHAS
Income Eligibility	You are member of a family whose income is equal to or less than 185% of the 2020 federal poverty level .	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tax return • Free school lunch letter
