

- a) **Income:** Individuals must meet at least one of the following income criteria:
- is eligible for free or reduced-price lunch during the most recent or current school year;
 - is a current WIOA youth participant;
 - has been determined eligible for WIOA Youth Services based upon family income within the previous 6 months;
 - is a recipient of SNAP (formerly Food Stamps);
 - is a recipient of Temporary Family Assistance (TANF);
 - is a recipient of State Administered General Assistance (SAGA) - cash or medical;
 - is a youth with disability meeting criteria outlined in WIOA eligibility directives;
 - is a foster child;
 - is pregnant or is a custodial parent;
 - is a member of a family whose income is equal to or less than 185% of the 2020 federal poverty level.
