The COVID-19 Disaster Relief Employment & Training Program Grant is designed to help laid-off Connecticut residents take charge of their futures and prepare to get back to work.

Short-term Job Opportunities

The COVID-19 pandemic has created temporary disaster relief jobs aimed at helping to combat the spread of COVID-19 and protect those who have the highest risk of contracting the virus.

Disaster Relief jobs/duties include:

- Cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting public facilities
- Delivering medicine, food or other supplies to quarantined individuals and vulnerable populations
- Healthcare support jobs such as CNA, home health aide, pharmacy tech and dietary aide.



The Covid-19 Grant Program offers:

- Placement with a local employer, for 30-40 hours a week.
- A job that will last approximately 3 to 9 months. There is an opportunity for a permanent position with some employers.
- Valuable job skills to help build your resume.
- You are an employee of the company and receive the same benefits as other employees.
- OSHA safety Training is provided to all participants.

Other Program Benefits

- We provide you with career assistance to translate your new job skills into a permanent position.
- Potential for additional training if required.

The employer receives full wage reimbursement and the Program also pays for any personal protective equipment (PPE) that may be needed for the job.
